Context



Abidjan COP 11 (March 2015): Decision CP. 11/10 on the Conservation and Sustainable use of Marine Biodiversity of the Areas Located beyond National Jurisdictions

Creation of a working group to study all aspects of the conservation and sustainable use of marine biodiversity in ABNJ within the framework of the Abidjan Convention

Which mandate for this Working Group? Which "aspects" to study? Which programme of work?

Objectives of the workshop



- To update participants on the negotiation process towards the elaboration of an UNCLOS IA
- To inform participants on existing regional initiatives in ABNJ, e.g. in the North-East Atlantic, Mediterranean, the Southern Ocean, Sargasso Sea regions
- To elaborate draft terms of reference (ToR) for the Working Group, as well as its draft programme of work (PoW), for consideration by the Abidjan Convention Parties.
