3. Visa Arrangements

Participants, who require visa for entry into Belgium, are kindly requested to make their own arrangements for issuance of visa. All delegates are advised to carry their yellow fever vaccination certificate.

4. Transport from Airport to Hotel

Participants are kindly requested to make their own airport transfer arrangements. TAXI

Catch a taxi from the taxi rink just outside the arrivals hall. You should expect to pay around 35-40 euros for the taxi ride.

AIRPORT EXPRESS BUS

Catch the airport express bus (number 12 on weekdays or number 21 on weekend days). Bus platforms are on the lower level. A one-way ticket will cost 4 to 5 euros (cheaper when bought in the ticket machine on the bus platform rather than from the driver) or 5 euros when bought from the driver, and the bus will bring you to either Schuman or Luxemburg Station stops. UNEP offices are within walking distance from the Luxemburg Station stop (last stop). Check which is the final stop when boarding the bus, as it may be worthwhile waiting for the next bus, if end destination is not Luxemburg. The Luxembourg bus stop is located in <u>Rue des Treves</u>, marked with number 32 on the map (see the red circle).

AIRPORT TRAIN


Last alternative is to catch a train into town. The train station is on the lowest level at the airport. Purchase a ticket for Brussels. The cost for a one-way train ticket is EUR 6,60.


Check the schedule and the platform for the train to Brussels.

Get off at Gare du Luxembourg for the UNEP office. We are located just a few blocks from the train station, approximately 5 minutes on foot. (Refer to attached map.)

In most cases you may need to switch trains in Gare du Nord (go to platform 7 for departures to Brussels-Luxemburg), as there aren't many direct trains from the airport.Map:

The standard voltage is 230 V. The standard frequency is 50 Hz. The power sockets that are used are of type E. Below is a picture of a power socket and corresponding plugs. If your appliances have a different shape, you may need a plug adapter.
