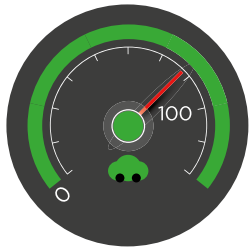

Background

In collaboration with the Transport stream of the IEA's Energy Efficiency Training week, the Global Fuel Economy Initiative's global training and networking event aims to equip countries to implement measures to improve vehicle fuel economy.

2016 is an important year for the Global Fuel Economy Initiative. Last year we launched our '100 for 50 by 50' initiative which encouraged new countries to commit to contributing to GFEI's goal of doubling average fuel economy globally by 2030 for new vehicles. By the global climate change talks in Paris in December 2015 we were able to announce that, thanks to new funding, GFEI will be supporting 40 new countries to start developing new fuel economy policies, and taking the number we have projects with to 65.

GFEI's Global Training and Networking event is an opportunity for new and existing countries to come together and learn from GFEI's experts, and share their own experiences of implementing fuel economy policies, as well as others who may be interested in learning more. There will be sessions on the latest trends in fuel economy globally, how to understand the average vehicle fuel economy of a vehicle fleet, calculating the costs and benefits of fuel economy, and fiscal measures.
