City Profile

- The City is situated along the Sea side of Bay of Bengal on the East Coast of India at the equidistance between Kolkata and Chennai
- The Urban Centre is spread over 534 Sq. Kms with Coast line of Bay of Bengal and the Port on the East, industrial belt on one side extended to West and the Urban Agglomeration with green space and hills in between
- The present population is around 20 Lakhs based on 2011 Census
- The Urban Centre attained Corporation status during the year 1979
- Visakhapatnam Municipal Corporation attained Greater status during the year 2005
- 40% Urban population as against state level average of 27%.
- Urban infra expansion and improvement for up-gradation under progress.
- Mobility of transport requires special attention with respect to non motor vehicles for pollution control


POTENTIAL OF THE CITY

- Health City with Major Health Units like K.G.H., VIMS, Apollo, L.V. Prasad Eye Institute, Care, Seven Hills, etc.







ARIAL VIEW - GVMC



- Despite it's potentials, Visakhapatnam City is declared as the 7th pollutant city in the Country, some of them are
- Pollution more due to Port Trust, Steel Plant, Petroleum Refinery, Pharma City, etc.

- Minimum usage of Bi-cycles and increasing number of two wheelers causing the pollution further.


NEED FOR CYCLING TRACKS IN VISAKHAPATNAM

- A 10Km stretch of Beach Road
- 42Km of BRTS Roads developed under JNNURM
- Demolition of cellars leaving space for cycling tracks by avoiding congestion of parking places on the Roads
- Creation of Hawkers Zones

- Introduction of Cycling clubs involving various NGOs at ward level in the city







CREATION OF HAWKER ZONES

- To avoid Traffic menace due to street vendors occupying the carriageway, GVMC created *Hawker Zones* in all 6 zones.
- Street vendors rehabilitated to the newly constructed Hawker zones, paving the way for creating Cycling lanes in the existing Right of Way.
- Cycle lanes will be created in the places earlier occupied by the vendors.



PRESENT PROJECT

w With the experience gained in the last 5 months and looking at the enthusiasm of the citizens, GVMC planned to create cycling lanes with pedestrian walk ways in the Core City (CBD Area) to promote Cycling & Walking in about 11.6 kms. (23.2 Kms. both sides), the details of proposals are listed below.


COMPONENTS OF THE PROJECT

- 2 Mts. Wide exclusive Bi-cycle lane separated with Thermo-plastic paint.
- Intermittent Mountable kerbs for Bi-cycle lane with painting for separation.
- Modification of pedestrian walkways with designer tiles for aesthetic look and user friendly walkways.
- Minor repairs to the drain cover slabs wherever required.
- Traffic signals showing Bi-cycles, Pedestrians, Studs and other road furniture for safety and guidance.
- Cost of the Project Rs. 10.24 Cr. (11.6 x 2 = 23.20 Kms.)


- * An unique project proposed by GVMC for environmental sustainability by reducing the pollution by developing cycling lanes and Walkways *under pilot basis*.
