





- Integrated public waterways project Kochi: (KMRL and
 Kerala) approx. EUR 85 million aim seamless mobility:
- (appraisal in August 2015; DEA/MUD approvals awaited)
- Integrated BRT Systems aim Multi modal integration
- Chennai:, Transport Dept, approx. EUR 180 mn;
- Coimbatore (MAWS, TN) DPR under preparation
- Bangalore: (DULT, Karnataka) approx. 130 mn Euros
 - integration of BRT with metro; pre appraisal of the BRT project in August 2014

Metro Rail Projects:

- EUR 500 million OPL (Nagpur metro with feeder systems)
- EUR 500 million ODA plus Loan (OPL) for Bangalore
