#### Annotations to the provisional agenda

#### **Item 1: Opening of the session**

- 1. Pursuant to General Assembly resolution 67/213, of 21 December 2012, the first universal session of the Governing Council/Global Ministerial Environment Forum of the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) will be opened at 10 a.m. on Monday, 18 February 2013, by the President of the Council or, in his absence, by one of the other officers of the Council/Forum at its twenty-sixth session.
- 2. Pursuant to General Assembly resolution 67/213, the Governing Council at the current session will use its applicable rules of procedure and applicable rules and practices of the General Assembly, pending the adoption of its new rules of procedure.

#### **Item 2: Organization of work**

#### (a) Election of officers

3. The Council elects its officers at the beginning of each regular session, in accordance with rule 18 of its rules of procedure. An explanation of the geographical composition of the Bureau from 1991 to 2011 together with the notification of the current session, dated 5 December 2012, was distributed to all Governments, accredited international non-governmental organizations, relevant intergovernmental organizations and United Nations agencies.

#### (b) Adoption of the agenda and organization of work

4. Pursuant to the General Assembly resolution 67/213, the Council at its current session is mandated to expeditiously initiate the implementation of the provisions contained in paragraph 88 of the outcome document, entitled "The future we want", of the United Nations Conference on Sustainable Development (Rio+20), held in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, in June 2012, in its entirety, make a recommendation on its designation to reflect its universal character, and decide on future arrangements for the Global Ministerial Environment Forum. Bearing this in mind, the Council will adopt its agenda on the basis of the provisional agenda for the session (UNEP/GC.27/1), as approved by the Council at its twenty-sixth session, which was distributed together with the notification of the session. The tentative programme of meetings of the Council/Forum may be found in the annex to the present document. The list of documents may be found in document UNEP/GC.27/INF/1. Additional information on the Council/Forum is available on the dedicated website for the session

(www.unep.org/gc/gc27). Updated information on all meetings and events may be found in journals that will be issued daily for the duration of the session and will also be displayed on video screens around the conference premises. Informal consultations in regional groups will be held on Sunday, 17 February 2013, the day before the opening of the session.

- 5. The Executive Director recommends that, at its plenary meeting on the morning of Monday, 18 February, the Council elect its officers and adopt the agenda and consider the organization of work for the session under agenda items 2 (a) and (b), respectively. The Executive Director also recommends that the Council/Forum establish sessional committees, including a committee of the whole.
- 6. During this meeting, the Executive Director will present his policy statement, which will be made available upon delivery as document UNEP/GC.27/2, including through the above-mentioned dedicated website.
- 7. Pursuant to General Assembly resolution 53/242, of 28 July 1999, the Governing Council constitutes an annual ministerial-level global environmental forum to review important and emerging policy issues in the field of the environment. In view of this mandate, the Executive Director recommends that the Council/Forum meet in the form of ministerial-level consultations, beginning on the afternoon of Monday, 18 February, with meetings continuing through the afternoon of Wednesday, 20 February 2013.
- 8. The Executive Director also recommends that, at the plenary meeting on the afternoon of Friday, 22 February, the Council consider the report of the Committee of the Whole and the relevant draft decisions. In this regard, the attention of the Council/Forum is drawn to the draft decisions prepared by the Committee of Permanent Representatives to UNEP, as set out in document UNEP/GC.27/L.1. These draft decisions are submitted in keeping with the Committee's mandate as set out in decision 19/32 of 4 April 1997.
- 9. In addition, the Executive Director recommends that items 3 (Credentials of representatives); 8 (Other matters); 9 (Adoption of the report); and 10 (Closure of the session) be considered during the plenary meeting on the afternoon of Friday, 22 February 2013.
- 10. The proceedings of the Council/Forum, including the plenary meetings, the ministerial round tables, and the meetings of the Committee of the Whole, will be conducted with simultaneous interpretation into the six official languages of the United Nations.

#### (c) Greening the Governing Council

- 11. In an effort to make the current session as climate-neutral and environmentally friendly as possible, a number of measures have been put in place, including the offsetting of greenhouse gas emissions for the travel to and stay in Nairobi of participants sponsored by UNEP, a reduction in the number of hard copies of all documents.
- 12. In accordance with established UNEP practice, the first universal session will be "paper-smart". Electronic copies of all pre-session and in-session documents have been or will be made available in the conference rooms through dedicated portals. To make the best use of this service, delegates are encouraged to bring their laptops to the session. For access to documents prior to the session, delegates are requested to visit the dedicated website for the session and download any copies required.
- 13. All participants are invited to consider offsetting the greenhouse gas emissions created as a result of their travel to and stay in Nairobi.

#### (d) Ministerial consultations

- 14. Eight months after Rio+20, the first universal session will mark an important milestone in the history of UNEP, in particular with regard to the realization of the strengthening and upgrading of the Programme, as called for in the outcome document of Rio+20, entitled "The future we want". In that regard, it is suggested that the session will hold ministerial-level consultations on the theme "Rio+20: from outcome to implementation" under provisional agenda item 4 (b) (Emerging policy issues).
- 15. The ministerial consultations will begin with a scene-setting meeting, during the afternoon of Monday, 18 February, at which ministers will hear introductory remarks on the topics related to the implementation of paragraph 88 of the Rio+20 outcome document. It is recommended that on Tuesday, 19 February, ministers hold three parallel roundtable discussions in the morning and the afternoon. It is suggested that the morning round-table discussions focus on responsiveness to country needs; science-policy interface; secure, stable, adequate and increased financial resources to fulfill the UNEP mandate; stakeholders' participation; and future ministerial engagements and institutional arrangements, while afternoon round-table discussions focus on environmental challenges within

sustainable development and the UNEP contribution to the sustainable development goals; as well as promoting sustainable consumption and production.

- 16. Discussion papers prepared by the Executive Director will be before the Council to provide background information and stimulate the discussions (UNEP/GC.27/16/Add.1). Relevant information will also be provided in documents UNEP/GC.27/INF/3 and INF/5. The outcome of the ministerial consultations will be presented at the plenary meeting on the afternoon of Wednesday, 20 February.
- 17. A special ministerial-level lunch time dialogue on the green economy in the context of sustainable development and poverty eradication will be held on Tuesday, 19 February, to provide a forum for interactive dialogue on this topic. A background information paper will inform the discussions (UNEP/GC.27/INF/19).
- 18. Ministers and heads of delegations are invited to regional ministerial consultations on environmental challenges and the regional presence and responsiveness of UNEP, to be held from 10 a.m. to 11.30 a.m. on Wednesday, 20 February, followed by ministerial consultations with the Executive Director on key issues from 11.30 a.m. to 1 p.m. on the same morning.

#### (e) Committee of the Whole

- 19. The Committee of the Whole is expected to begin its work during the afternoon of Monday, 18 February. The Committee will elect its own officers in accordance with rule 61 of the rules of procedure, with the exception of its Chair. In the past, the Council/Forum has designated one of its vice-presidents as the chair of the Committee of the Whole.
- 20. The Executive Director recommends that the Committee of the Whole take up all other items of the provisional agenda which are not taken up in the plenary meetings. Substantive topics to be considered under each of those agenda items are described in the paragraphs below.
- 21. It is envisaged that the Committee of the Whole will conclude its work at its afternoon meeting on Thursday, 21 February 2013, with the adoption of its report. That report will be submitted for adoption at the plenary meeting during the afternoon of Friday, 22 February 2013.

#### (f) Pre-session events

22. The Council/Forum will be preceded by a number of events, including the fourteenth Global Major Groups and Stakeholders Forum, on 16 and 17 February 2013, a high-level meeting on the rule of law and the environment and a meeting of the Network of Women Ministers and Leaders for the Environment: high-level forum on gender and the environment, both on 17 February.

#### (g) Side events and exhibitions

23. Side events will be held during the lunch break each day, with the exception of Tuesday, 19 February, on matters of relevance to the Council/Forum deliberations. Details of these events, along with those of social events and relevant parallel events, may be found in the daily journal. Representatives are encouraged to participate in these events.

24. In accordance with rule 17 of the rules of procedure, the credentials of representatives at the first universal session of the Council will be examined by the Bureau, which will report thereon to the Council/Forum.
