## **Delivering on the SDGs**



We provide countries with post-conflict assistance to ensure the health of people and the environment in the aftermath of a crisis.



We help countries implement national plans on waste management and sustainable consumption and production.



Our programmes restore ecosystems and combat desertification and sand and dust storms



We empower young people through Green Universities Networks and other innovative approaches to youth engagement.



We help governments track their greenhouse gas emissions, adapt to climate change and move towards a low-carbon development path.



We support the development of regional strategies to protect oceans and coastal zones.



We assess water vulnerability and help countries develop strategies to boost water security.



We build institutional capacity on environmental laws and policies, assist in monitoring, help countries fulfill their obligations under UN Conventions and multilateral environmental agreements, and support regional fora in setting priorities and formulating strategies.

## Snapshot: The Marshlands of Mesopotamia

The Marshlands of Mesopotamia, located in Southern Iraq, were once home to several hundred thousand inhabitants, the Ma'dan, a people whose way of life has been preserved for over 5,000 years. But since the 1970s, the Marshlands have been damaged by dam construction, drainage for agriculture, oil exploration, war, drought and climate change.

UNEP and its partners have been working in the Marshlands for more than a decade despite Iraq's unstable security situation. With UNEP's support, the Iraqi Government has developed a management plan to ensure a steady water flow, prevent pollution and provide a sustainable environment for local communities.

## **Our Plan**

- We are looking for \$1.5 million to support the follow-up to the recommendations from UNEP's Desk Studies on the environment in Palestine, an area that has undergone a series of conflicts that have seriously affected natural resources and the environment.
- We aim to scale up our support to countries to implement the Paris Agreement and participate in cooperation mechanisms on technology, capacity building and finance.
   We plan to attract roughly \$25 million in new funding from the GEF and the Green Climate Fund for the coming five years.
- We plan to help 12 countries implement their strategies on climate change, desertification, biodiversity, and chemicals by encouraging investments of at least \$3 million in pilot projects.
- We are looking to secure \$2 million over the next two years to help Arab countries green their economies by enhancing South-South cooperation and empowering youth.
