Enacted in October 1972

- STANDARDS DEVELOPMENT
 - Petrol- MS 170: 2012
 - Leaded fuel >Unleaded fuel
 - Illuminating Paraffin–MS 498:2008
 - Flash point
 - Diesel-MS 538: 2008
 - 5,000 > 500 > **50 ppm**
 - 50 ppm with effect from 1st January, 2016



FUEL QUALITY IMPROVEMENTS INITIATIVE

MONITORING

- Countrywide monitoring of fuels in collaboration with the regulator MERA
 - Quarterly sampling of fuels from filling stations and depots
 - MBS plays provides Testing services

TESTING CAPACITY

- Lab equipped with testing facilities that analyses
 - Water content
 - Distillation characteristics
 - Flash point
 - Viscosity
