#### HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT

Approach:

- Programme launched to support the AU 2050 AIM Strategy
- Current partners: SAMSA, SAIMI, NMMU
- Study to assess pan-African human resource capacity and needs in the maritime sector
- African Maritime Domain Conference and workshops
  - AMD conference every 2-3 years
  - Targeted thematic workshops to address key issues
