مشروع القرار IG.23/1: الصيغة المنقحة لتقديم التقارير بشأن تنفيذ اتفاقية برشلونة لحماية البيئة البحرية والمناطق الساحلية للبحر الأبيض المتوسط وبروتوكولاتها

نظرًا لدواع بيئية ودواعي توفير التكاليف، طُبِعَت هذه الوثيقة بعددٍ محدودٍ. ويُرجى من المُوفَدِين التكرم بإحضار نُسخهم في الاجتماعات وعدم طلب نُسخ إضافية.

خلفية عامة

 طلب الاجتماع الثامن عشر للأطراف المتعاقدة في اتفاقية حماية البيئة البحرية والمناطق الساحلية للبحر الأبيض المتوسط وبروتوكولاتها (إسطنبول، تركيا، 3-6 ديسمبر 2013)، في قراره IG.21/2، من الأمانة أن تعد، بالتشاور مع لجنة الامتثال، مسودة مبسطة وعملية لصيغة تقديم التقارير بشأن تنفيذ اتفاقية برشلونة وبروتوكولاتها، التي أقرها أصلاً اجتماع الأطراف المتعاقدة الخامس عشر (ألميريا، إسبانيا، 15-18 يناير/كانون الثاني 2008) بموجب القرار IG. 17/3.

 بموجب قراره IG. 22/16، كرر اجتماع الأطراف المتعاقدة التاسع عشر (أثينا، اليونان، 9-12 فبر اير/شباط 2016) طلبه بخصوص إعداد صيغة مبسطة، ودعا الأطراف المتعاقدة إلى النظر في المشاركة في اختبارها بغرض وضع صيغتها النهائية للتشاور كتابياً مع جهات اتصال خطة عمل البحر الأبيض المتوسط ثم تقديمها إلى اجتماع الأطراف المتعاقدة العشرين (تيرانا، ألبانيا، 20-10 ديسمبر/كانون الأول 2017).

3. وإذ مضت الأمانة قُدماً في هذا العمل، فإنها وبالتشاور مع لجنة الامتثال وعناصر برنامج الأمم المتحدة للبيئة/خطة عمل البحر الأبيض المتوسط أعدت صيغة منقحة لتقديم التقارير وقدمتها إلى الاجتماع الثاني عشر للجنة الامتثال (أثينا، اليونان، 24-25 يناير/كانون الثاني 2017) واجتماعات عناصر خطة عمل البحر الأبيض المتوسط. أسفر هذا عن مزيد من التهذيب للمسودة، التي تم تعميمها لاختبار ها بين جهات اتصال خطة عمل البحر الأبيض المتوسط. لم يشارك سوى طرفين متعاقدين في عملية الاختبار وقدما تعليقاتهما.

4. راجع اجتماع جهات اتصال خطة عمل البحر الأبيض المتوسط (أثينا، اليونان، 12-15 سبتمبر /أيلول 2017) مشروع القرار وصدّق عليه للعرض على أنظار الأطراف المتعاقدة في اجتماعها العشرين.

5. تعكس هذه الفقرة التطورات ذات العلاقة بمسودة الصيغة المنقحة لتقديم التقارير في أعقاب اجتماع جهات اتصال خطة عمل البحر الأبيض المتوسط:

(2) التعليقات المقدمة في سياق في سياق عملية اختبار مسودة الصيغة المنقحة لتقديم التقارير : في أعقاب اجتماعيين ثنائيين مع اثنين من الأطراف المتعاقدة تمخضا عن تعليقات على الصيغة المنقحة لتقديم التقارير ، تُقتر ح إمكانية تهذيب الصيغة المنقحة على النحو التالي عند تطبيقها.

a. الجداول التي تتناول "التدابير القانونية والتنظيمية": ينبغي توسيع عمود "وضع" التنفيذ ليشمل خياراً جديداً (وهو "جزئياً") لكي يعكس حقيقة أن المتطلب يكون في بعض الحالات مطبقاً جزئياً في الإطار القانوني والتنظيمي المعمول به؛

b. القسم 1-اتفاقية برشلونة، الجدول "التدابير القانونية والتنظيمية": ينبغي أن يكون السؤلان 13 (تقييم الأثر البيئي العابر للحدود) و14 (الإدارة المتكاملة للمناطق الساحلية) في القسم السابق لا تحت الإبلاغ الاختياري، وذلك باعتبار المواد (ع) (3) (د) و(ه) من اتفاقية برشلونة؛

c. القسم 4 بروتوكول المصادر البرية: الجدول الثاني "قائمة جرد: بروتوكول حماية البحر الأبيض المتوسط من التلوث من مصادر وأنشطة برية، المادة 13 (ج)": ينبغي أيضاً أن تكون وحدات الإبلاغ عن الكمية الإجمالية من الملوثات المنطلقة في الهواء أو المياه أو التربة من كل قطاعات النشاط على هيئة "طن/سنة"، مما يتيح للأطراف المتعاقدة المرونة للإبلاغ باستخدام "كمر سنة" أو "طن/ سنة"، على حسب الكميات ذات الصلة؛

- d. القسم 5-بروتوكول المناطق المشمولة بحماية خاصة والتنوع البيولوجي:
- الجدول الحادي عشر "تدابير الإنفاذ"، ينبغي إدراج عمود جديد ليبيّن العدد الإجمالي لتدابير الإنفاذ؛
- الجدول الثاني عشر "تنفيذ خطط العمل الإقليمية"، الجدول الخاص بتقديم التقارير بشأن تنفيذ خطة العمل الإقليمية المتعلقة بالأنواع الغربية والغازية (قرار مؤتمر الأطراف IG 22/12). ينبغي توسيع السؤال الأول "وضع آلية لتشجيع وتنسيق الإجراءات المذكورة في الفقرة 22 من خطة العمل الإقليمية - الجدول الزمني 2016" إلى عدد الإجراءات المذكورة في الفقرة 22 من خطة العمل الإقليمية. الإجراءات مبينة حالياً في الحاشية رقم 1 الخاصة بالسؤال؛
- الجدول الثاني عشر "تنفيذ خطط العمل الإقليمية"، الجدول الخاص بتقديم التقارير بشأن تنفيذ خطة العمل الإقليمية المتعلقة بالشعاب المرجانية والصخور البيولوجية الجيرية الأخرى، (قرار مؤتمر الأطراف IG 22/12). توخياً للوضوح، ينبغي تنقيح السؤال الأول على النحو التالي: تحسين أساليب نمذجة الموائل بشأن توزيع المرجانيات، وتوجيه عمليات المسح الميداني الفعالة من حيث التكلفة للحصول على البيانات".

e. القسم 07 من بروتوكول النفايات الخطرة: ينبغي تحديث السنوات المذكورة في الجدولين الثالث والرابع لتطابق سنوات الإبلاغ.

اعتبارات عامة

6. أعيد تصميم مسودة الصيغة المنقحة لتقديم التقارير على النحو الوارد في مسودة القرار المرفقة بغية تحقيق هدف ثنائي، وهو تبسيط عملية التقرير الوطنية وزيادة ملاءمة التقارير الوطنية.

7. يُتوقع أن يسهّل تبسيط صيغة تقديم التقارير ومتطلبات المعلومات عبء الإبلاغ الواقع على الأطراف المتعاقدة. ينبغي أن تشجع التقارير المبسطة أيضاً على استجابة أكثر اتساقاً بين الأطراف المتعاقدة ومن سنة إلى أخرى من جانب الطرف المتعاقد الواحد. ينبغي أن يؤدي هذا إلى جمع المزيد من المعلومات المتسقة لتجميعها وتحليلها بمعرفة الأمانة بغية تقديمها إلى هيئات خطة عمل البحر الأبيض المتوسط ذات العلاقة.

8. من شأن تقديم تجميعات أكثر تركيزاً وأيسر استخداماً للمعلومات المقدمة من الأطراف المتعاقدة في التقارير الوطنية أن يجعل هذه التقارير أعظم نفعاً للأطراف المتعاقدة. إذا اعتُبرت التقارير الوطنية كمنصة يمكن للأطراف المتعاقدة من خلالها بيان التقدم الذي تحرزه و/أو الصعوبات التي تواجهها في تنفيذ الاتفاقية والبروتوكولات، فهذا أيضاً من شأنه أن يبرز مكانة التقارير الوطنية.

.9 تتضمن مسودة الصيغة المنقحة لتقديم التقارير الملامح الرئيسية التالية:

a) توفر أقساماً مسبقة الملء مما يسهّل على الأطر اف المتعاقدة تقديم تحديثات حول التغيرات التي حدثت منذ التقرير السابق. سيتضمن هذا ببساطة وضع علامة على خانة "نعم" أو "لا" المناسبة، وذلك تبعاً لما إذا كان هناك أي تغيير في المعلومات المقدمة، أثناء فترة التقرير السابقة؛

b) تعزز التوحيد مع عمليات الإبلاغ الداخلية الأخرى، مما يتفادى بالتالي الاز دواجية في مجموعات البيانات المحتفظ بها لدى مراكز الأنشطة الإقليمية. لهذا الغرض، أعيد تنظيم الصيغة بإعطاء الأطراف المتعاقدة المرونة للرجوع إلى مجموعات بيانات مراكز الأنشطة الإقليمية حسب الاقتضاء؛

c) تعزز التكامل والتنسيق مع الإبلاغ العالمي والإقليمي ذي العلاقة، مما يخفف بالتالي العبء الواقع على الأطراف المتعاقدة لإعداد تقارير منفصلة حول تنفيذ اتفاقيات دولية مختلفة لكن وثيقة الصلة. مع وضع هذا بعين الاعتبار، تم توفيق الصيغة قدر المستطاع مع إجراءات التقرير الخاصة بالاتفاقيات العالمية والإقليمية ذات العلاقة، على سبيل المثال: اتفاقية لندن المتعلقة برمي النفايات وبروتوكولها، واتفاقية بازل، واتفاقياة استكهولم.

b) يفسح المجال أمام الأطراف المتعاقدة لبيان الصعوبات والتحديات المحتملة عند التقرير ، بحيث يمكن للأمانة العامة تقديم مختلف درجات وطرائق المشورة الفنية والقانونية. كما تعطي الأطراف المتعاقدة خيار تقديم معلومات مفصلة على أساس تطوعي باستخدام روابط الويب؛

e) تعكس الطبيعة الديناميكية لمنظومة خطة عمل البحر الأبيض المتوسط، بتضمين أحدث العمل وأوثقه صلة في مجال خطط العمل والاستراتيجيات الإقليمية وبرامج العمل الوطنية والمؤشرات.

اعتبارات معينة

9. نتألف مسودة الصيغة المنقحة لتقديم التقارير من سبعة أقسام مستقلة لكل وثيقة على النحو التالي: (1) القسم 1-اتفاقية بر شلونة، و(2) القسم 2- بروتوكول المصادر البرية، و(2) القسم 4- بروتوكول المصادر البرية، و(3) القسم 5- بروتوكول المناح و الموارئ، و(4) القسم 6- بروتوكول المصادر البرية، و(5) القسم 5- بروتوكول المناح و الموارئ، و(3) القسم 4- بروتوكول المناح و الموارئ، و(1) القسم 4- بروتوكول المصادر البرية، و(3) القسم 5- بروتوكول المنع و الطوارئ، و(4) القسم 6- بروتوكول المصادر البرية، و(3) القسم 5- بروتوكول المناح و النتوع البيولوجي، و(6) القسم 6- البروتوكول البحري، و(7) القسم 7- بروتوكول الماطق المشمولة بحماية خاصة و النتوع البيولوجي، و(6) القسم 6- البروتوكول البحري، و(7) القسم 7- بروتوكول الماطق المشمولة بحماية خاصة و النتوع البيولوجي، و(6) القسم 6- البروتوكول البحري، و(7) القسم 7- بروتوكول الماطق المشمولة بحماية خاصة و النتوع البيولوجي، و(6) القسم 6- البروتوكول البحري، و(7) القسم 7- بروتوكول الناية المالية، تُدخل مسودة الصيغة المنقحة لتقديم التقارير التغيير ات الأساسية التالية في كل بروتوكول النفايات الخطرة.

10. القسم 1-اتفاقية برشلونة: للحد من كمية المعلومات المقدمة، حُذف الجدول الوارد بشأن حالة التصديق في مسودة الصيغة المنقحة لتقديم التقارير ؛ حيث إن هذه المعلومات تقدمها الدولة الوديعة إلى الأمانة.

11. القسم 2- بروتوكول الإلقاء: استُحدث هذا القسم لتيسير تنفيذ التزام تقديم التقارير بموجب المادة 26 من اتفاقية برشلونة والمادتين 8 و14(2)(ب) من بروتوكول الإلقاء، بمعنى تقديم المعلومات عن تشريع تنفيذ بروتوكول الإلقاء وكميات وأنواع النفايات المسموح بها والملقاة، وطريقة الإلقاء.

(ج) الجدول 6 (وضع الشعاب الاصطناعية). أضيف الجدول 6 لكي يعكس أحدث التطور ات فيما يتعلق بالوضع في البحر بموجب المادة 3(4) (ب) من بروتوكول الإلقاء، وهو يسهل تقديم المعلومات بشأن وضع الشعاب الاصطناعية.

12. <u>القسم 3-بروتوكول المنع والطوارئ:</u> هذا القسم مرتب لتبسيط تنفيذ التزامات التقرير بموجب المادة 26 من اتفاقية برشلونة والمادة 4 (خطط الطوارئ والسبل الأخرى لمنع ومكافحة حوادث التلوث)، والمادة 7 (نشر المعلومات وتبادلها)، والمادة 9 (عملية الإبلاغ)، والمادة 10 (التدابير التشغيلية)، والمادة 16 (استقبال السفن المستغيثة في الموانئ وأماكن اللجوء) ببروتوكول المنع والطوارئ.

(أ) الجدول الأول (التدابير القانونية والتنظيمية). يبسّط الجدول 1 الجدول الأول (التدابير القانونية والإدارية) في الصيغة الحالية، وذلك ضمن جملة أمور بالتفرقة بين التقرير الإلزامي والاختياري. فيما يخص العناصر غير الإلزامية للبروتوكول، يصير الإبلاغ اختيارياً، مما يخفف بالتالي عبء الإبلاغ الواقع على الأطراف المتعاقدة؛

(ب) الجدول الثاني (التدابير التنفيذية). يجمع الجدول الثاني بين الجدول الخامس (التدابير الفنية المتخذة) والجدول السادس (التدابير التشغيلية المتخذة) في الصيغة الحالية، وذلك في محاولة لترشيد وتبسيط تقديم المعلومات بإعطاء المرونة للأطراف المتعاقدة لتحميل البيانات إما من الأقسام ذات العلاقة في المواجز القطرية للمركز الإقليمي للاستجابة في حالات الطوارئ الناشئة عن التلوث البحري أو مجموعات البيانات الوطنية؛

(ج) الجدول الثالث (حوادث التلوث). يحل الجدول الثالث محل الجدول السابع (حوادث الانسكاب) في الصيغة الحالية. يحذو الجديد حذو تنظيم قاعدة البيانات نظام المعلومات الجغرافية المتكامل المتوسطي بشأن تقييم مخاطر التلوث البحري والاستجابة له؛ وبالتالي فإذا تم تقديم المعلومات عن طريق قاعدة بيانات هذا النظام، فلا حاجة إلى فعل ذلك من جديد، مما يتفادى بالتالي از دو اجية البيانات من مصادر بيانات مختلفة إلى المتلومية المتكامل المتوسطي مشأن تقييم مخاطر التلوث البحري والاستجابة للمتوسطي مشأن تقييم مخاطر التلوث البحري والاستجابة لله؛ وبالتالي فإذا تم تقديم المعلومات عن طريق قاعدة بيانات هذا النظام، فلا حاجة إلى فعل ذلك من جديد، مما يتفادى بالتالي از دو اجية البيانات من مصادر بيانات مختلفة؛

(أ) الجدول الأول (التدابير القانونية والتنظيمية). يدمج الجدول الأول ويبسط الجدول الأول (التدابير القانونية) والجدول الثاني (تخصيص الموارد) في الصيغة الحالية، مما يسهّل بالتالي تقديم المعلومات حول الإطار القانوني و/أو التنظيمي الموضوع من قبل الأطراف المتعاقدة لتنفيذ بروتوكول المصادر البرية؛

(ب) الجدول الثاني (قائمة الجرد - المادة 13(ج) من بروتوكول المصادر البرية). يحل الجدول الثاني محل الجدول الثالث-1 (معلومات إحصائية بشأن التفويضات) والجدول الثالث-2 (كميات الملوثات المنصرفة) في الصيغة الحالية. صُمم الجدول الجديد بحيث تنتفي الحاجة إلى إعادة تقديم البيانات في حالة تقديمها عن طريق نظام NBB على الإنترنت التابع للبرنامج المنسق لمراقبة ودراسة التلوث في منطقة البحر الأبيض المتوسط، مما يتفادى بالتالي از دواجية مجموعات البيانات التي يحتفظ بها البرنامج؛

 (د) الجدول الرابع (تنفيذ خطط العمل الوطنية وفعاليتها) والجدول الخامس (الرصد). يمثل الجدول الرابع والخامس نسخة منقحة من الجدول الخامس (تنفيذ خطط العمل الوطنية) والجدول الرابع (تنفيذ الرصد) في الصيغة الحالية، وذلك بهدف تضمين أحدث العمل وأوثقه صلة في مجال خطط العمل الوطنية والمؤشرات، مما يعكس بالتالي الطبيعة المتطورة لإطار برنامج الأمم المتحدة للبيئة/خطة عمل البحر الأبيض المتوسط.
