Proyecto de decisión IG.23/1: Formato revisado de presentación de informes para la aplicación del Convenio para la Protección del Medio Marino y de la Región Costera del Mediterráneo y sus Protocolos

Por motivos ambientales y de ahorro, la tirada del presente documento es limitada. Se ruega a las delegaciones que lleven sus ejemplares a las reuniones y no soliciten copias adicionales.

Nota de la Secretaría

Antecedentes

1. La 18.^a reunión de las Partes Contratantes en el Convenio para la Protección del Medio Marino y de la Región Costera del Mediterráneo y sus Protocolos (Estambul, Turquía, 3 a 6 de diciembre de 2013), en su decisión IG.21/2, solicitó a la secretaría que elaborara, en consulta con el Comité de Cumplimiento, un proyecto simplificado y práctico del formato presentación de informes para la aplicación del Convenio de Barcelona y sus Protocolos, el cual fue aprobado originalmente por la 15.^a reunión de las Partes Contratantes (Almería, 15 a 18 de enero de 2008) en la decisión IG.17/3.

2. En su decisión IG.22/16, la 19.ª reunión de las Partes Contratantes (Atenas, Grecia, 9 a 12 de febrero de 2016) reiteró la solicitud de un formato simplificado e invitó a las Partes Contratantes a que se plantearan la posibilidad de participar en su fase de prueba, con miras a concluirlo, someterlo a consulta escrita con los puntos focales del Plan de Acción para el Mediterráneo (PAM) y presentarlo posteriormente en la 20.ª reunión de las Partes Contratantes (Tirana (Albania), 17 a 20 de diciembre de 2017).

3. Llevando adelante esta labor, la secretaría, en consulta con el Comité de Cumplimiento y los componentes del Plan de Acción para el Mediterráneo del Programa de las Naciones Unidas para el Medio Ambiente (PNUMA/PAM), preparó un proyecto del formato revisado de presentación de informes que presentó ante la 12.ª reunión del Comité de Cumplimiento (Atenas, Grecia, 24 y 25 de enero de 2017) y ante las reuniones de los componentes del PAM. Este proceso dio lugar a una versión más refinada del proyecto, que se distribuyó entre los puntos focales del PAM para que la probaran. Solo dos Partes Contratantes participaron en la fase de prueba y formularon observaciones al respecto.

4. En la reunión de los puntos focales del PAM (Atenas, Grecia, 12 a 15 de septiembre de 2017) se revisó el proyecto de decisión y se aprobó para su consideración por las Partes Contratantes en su 20.ª reunión.

5. Este párrafo muestra los avances logrados en relación con el proyecto del formato revisado de presentación de informes tras la reunión de los puntos focales del PAM:

(1) avances en el marco del Convenio de Minamata sobre el Mercurio: la primera reunión de la Conferencia de las Partes en el Convenio de Minamata sobre el Mercurio (Ginebra, 24 a 29 de septiembre de 2017) aprobó el formato de presentación de informes para el Convenio de Minamata sobre el Mercurio (UNEP/MC/COP/1/CRP.17). El formato de presentación de informes de Minamata tiene un alcance más amplio que el cuadro para la presentación de informes sobre la ejecución del Plan Regional sobre reducción del uso de insumos de mercurio (decisión IG.20/8.1) con arreglo a la parte III del Protocolo para la Protección del Mar Mediterráneo contra la Contaminación de Origen Terrestre. El cuadro complementa el formato de presentación de informes de Minamata;

(2) observaciones formuladas en el contexto de la prueba del proyecto del formato revisado de presentación de informes: tras mantener encuentros bilaterales con las dos Partes Contratantes que formularon observaciones acerca del formato revisado de presentación de informes, se sugiere que dicho formato podría refinarse de los siguientes modos en el momento de ponerlo en funcionamiento:

a. cuadros sobre "Medidas jurídicas y regulatorias": la columna "Situación" de la aplicación se debería ampliar e incorporar una nueva opción ("Parcialmente") para reflejar que, en algunos casos, el marco jurídico o regulatorio en vigor ha asumido parcialmente un requisito;

b. sección 1: Convenio de Barcelona, cuadro "Medidas jurídicas y regulatorias": habida cuenta de los artículos 4 3) d) y e) del Convenio de Barcelona, las preguntas 13 (evaluación del impacto ambiental transfronterizo) y 14 (gestión integrada de las zonas costeras) deben formar parte de la sección anterior, no de la referente a la presentación opcional de informes;

c. sección 4: Protocolo para la Protección del Mar Mediterráneo contra la

Contaminación de Origen Terrestre: cuadro II, "Inventario: artículo 13 c) del Protocolo para la Protección del Mar Mediterráneo contra la Contaminación de Origen Terrestre": es preciso añadir "toneladas/año" como unidad para indicar la cantidad total de contaminante liberada al aire, el agua o el suelo por todos los sectores de actividad, dando a las Partes Contratantes flexibilidad para informar sobre el asunto utilizando la medida "kg/año" o "toneladas/año" en función de las cantidades vertidas;

d. sección 5: Protocolo sobre las Zonas Especialmente Protegidas y la Diversidad Biológica del Mediterráneo:

- cuadro XI, "Medidas coercitivas": es preciso insertar una nueva columna que muestre el número total de medidas coercitivas aplicadas;
- cuadro XII, "Ejecución de los planes de acción regionales": cuadro para informar sobre la ejecución del Plan de Acción Actualizado relativo a la Introducción de Especies y las Especies Invasoras en el Mar Mediterráneo (decisión IG.22/12 de la COP). El primer asunto, "Crear un mecanismo para promover y coordinar las acciones enumeradas en el párrafo 22 - Plazo: 2016", debe ampliarse para incluir las medidas que figuran en el párrafo 22 de dicho programa. En la actualidad las medidas figuran en la nota al pie 1 del asunto;
- cuadro XII, "Ejecución de los planes de acción regionales": cuadro para informar sobre la ejecución del Plan de Acción Actualizado para la Conservación de las Formaciones Coralinas y otras Concreciones Biológicas Calcáreas en el Mar Mediterráneo (decisión IG.22/12 de la COP). En aras de la claridad, la primera pregunta debe modificarse del siguiente modo: "Mejorar los métodos de modelización de hábitats acerca de la distribución coralina y guiar la elaboración de estudios rentables sobre el terreno para la adquisición de datos".

e. Sección 7: Protocolo sobre la Prevención de la Contaminación del Mar Mediterráneo Causada por Movimientos Transfronterizos de Desechos Peligrosos y su Eliminación: los años de los cuadros III y IV deben actualizarse para coincidir con los años a que se refieren los informes.

Consideraciones generales

6. El proyecto del formato revisado de presentación de informes presentado en el proyecto de decisión adjunto ha sido rediseñado con un doble objetivo: simplificar el proceso nacional de presentación de informes y redoblar la importancia de los informes nacionales.

7. Se espera que simplificando el formato de presentación de informes y las exigencias de información se alivie la carga que supone presentar informes para las Partes Contratantes. Unos informes más simples deben favorecer igualmente la coherencia de las respuestas de las distintas Partes Contratantes y de las respuestas que una misma Parte Contratante da a lo largo de los años, lo cual debería resultar en la recopilación de datos más coherentes para que la secretaría los resuma y analice y se los presente a los órganos pertinentes del PAM.

8. Los informes nacionales podrían tener una utilidad mayor para las Partes Contratantes si contuvieran resúmenes más centrados y legibles de la información presentada por las Partes Contratantes. El prestigio de los informes nacionales también aumentaría si se los considerara una plataforma desde la que las Partes Contratantes pueden comunicar sus avances o dificultades en la ejecución del Convenio y sus Protocolos.

9. El proyecto del formato revisado de presentación de informes tiene las siguientes características:

a) contiene secciones previamente cumplimentadas, lo que facilita que las Partes Contratantes informen sobre las novedades o los cambios acontecidos desde el último informe. Para ello, simplemente tendrían que marcar el recuadro correspondiente ("Sí" o "No"), en función de si la

información presentada en el período anterior ha sufrido algún cambio;

 b) refuerza la alineación con otros procesos internos de presentación de informes, evitando así que dupliquen la información de los conjuntos de datos de que disponen los Centros de Actividades Regionales. El formato se ha reestructurado a tal fin, brindando a las Partes Contratantes la flexibilidad que necesitan para consultar los conjuntos de datos de los Centros de Actividades Regionales cuando proceda;

c) facilita la complementariedad y armonización con la presentación de informes mundiales y regionales de interés, reduciendo así el esfuerzo que tienen que hacer las Partes Contratantes para redactar informes independientes sobre la aplicación de convenios internacionales distintos pero conexos. Teniendo esto presente, el formato se ha ajustado todo lo posible a los procedimientos de presentación de informes de los convenios mundiales y regionales pertinentes, tales como el Convenio de Londres sobre Vertimiento y su Protocolo, el Convenio de Basilea y el Convenio de Estocolmo;

 d) brinda a las Partes Contratantes más oportunidades para explicar los posibles retos y dificultades que afrontan al presentar informes, de modo que la secretaría pueda proporcionar distintos niveles y modalidades de asesoramiento técnico y jurídico. También ofrece a las Partes Contratantes la opción de facilitar voluntariamente información detallada mediante enlaces web;

e) deja patente el carácter dinámico del sistema del PAM al incluir las actividades más recientes y relevantes en relación con los planes de acción regionales, los planes de acción nacionales y los indicadores.

Consideraciones específicas

9. El proyecto del formato revisado de presentación de informes está compuesto por las siguientes siete secciones independientes para cada instrumento: 1) sección 1 - Convenio de Barcelona; 2) sección - Protocolo sobre Vertimiento; 3) sección 3 - Protocolo de Cooperación para Luchar contra la Contaminación por Hidrocarburos y Otras Substancias Dañinas en Casos de Emergencia en el Mar Mediterráneo ; 4) sección 4 - Protocolo para la Protección del Mar Mediterráneo contra la Contaminación de Origen Terrestre; 5) sección 5 - Protocolo sobre las Zonas Especialmente Protegidas y la Diversidad Biológica del Mediterráneo; 6) sección 6 - Protocolo "Offshore", y 7) sección 7 - Protocolo sobre la Prevención de la Contaminación del Mar Mediterráneo Causada por Movimientos Transfronterizos de Desechos Peligrosos y su Eliminación. En comparación con el formato actual, el proyecto del formato revisado de presentación de informes realiza los siguientes cambios fundamentales en cada una de las secciones.

10. <u>Sección 1 - Convenio de Barcelona:</u> Con el propósito de reducir la cantidad de información facilitada, en el proyecto del formato revisado de presentación de informes se ha eliminado el cuadro sobre el estado de la ratificación, ya que el Estado depositario proporciona dicha información a la secretaría.

11. <u>Sección 2 - Protocolo sobre Vertimiento:</u> Esta sección tiene por objeto facilitar el cumplimiento de la obligación de presentación de informes contemplada en el artículo 26 del Convenio de Barcelona y los artículos 8 y 14 2) b) del Protocolo sobre Vertimiento, esto es, la presentación de información sobre la legislación relativa a la aplicación del Protocolo sobre Vertimiento, las cantidades y los tipos de residuos permitidos y vertidos, la ubicación y el método de vertimiento.

a) Cuadro 1 ("Medidas jurídicas y regulatorias"). El cuadro 1 aúna los cuadros 1 ("Medidas jurídicas") y II ("Asignación de recursos") del formato actual, con miras a informar sobre las leyes o

normas adoptadas por las Partes Contratantes para cumplir lo dispuesto en el Protocolo sobre Vertimiento, así como sobre las dificultades encontradas en su aplicación, de un modo más coherente. De ese modo se ha pulido aún más la descripción de las obligaciones, en línea con lo establecido en los artículos pertinentes del Protocolo sobre Vertimiento;

b) Cuadros 2 ("Permisos para el vertimiento en el mar y cantidades"), 3 ("Cantidades de residuos u otras materias vertidas en el mar para cada vertedero"), 4 ("Coordenadas de los vertederos") y 5 ("Vigilancia"). Los cuadros 2 a 5 sustituyen a los cuadros III ("Medidas administrativas"), IV ("Fuerza mayor"), V ("Situaciones críticas"), el cuadro VI ("Medidas coercitivas") y VII ("Aplicación de las directrices sobre vertimiento") del formato en vigor. Los nuevos cuadros contienen datos cuantitativos de conformidad con los artículos 6 y 10 del Protocolo sobre Vertimiento y se ajustan, mutatis mutandis, al formato revisado de presentación electrónica de informes del Convenio de Londres de 1976 y su Protocolo sobre Vertimiento de 1996 (LC 33/15, anexo 5). Este nuevo formato de cuadro: i) simplifica la obligación de las Partes Contratantes de preservar registros sobre las características y cantidades de los residuos u otras materias cuyo vertimiento está autorizado y sobre la ubicación, fecha y método de vertimiento, como exige el artículo 10 del Protocolo; ii) facilita que los países que sean Partes Contratantes del Protocolo de 1976 o el Protocolo de 1995 presenten los datos que deben; iii) ayuda a presentar datos sobre las vigilancias, incluidas las vigilancias sobre el terreno y de evaluación; y iv) establece un formato, armonizado con los avances internacionales pertinentes, para que los países mantengan registros de las autorizaciones, las cantidades, la ubicación y la vigilancia de las actividades de vertimiento;

c) Cuadro 6 ("Colocación de arrecifes artificiales"). Se ha añadido el cuadro 6 para reflejar los últimos avances en la colocación conforme al artículo 3 4) b) del Protocolo sobre Vertimiento. Dicho cuadro facilita la presentación de información sobre la colocación de arrecifes artificiales.

12. <u>Sección 3 - Protocolo de Cooperación para Luchar contra la Contaminación por</u> <u>Hidrocarburos y Otras Substancias Dañinas en Casos de Emergencia en el Mar Mediterráneo:</u> Esta sección se ha organizado para simplificar la observancia de las obligaciones de presentación de informes recogidas en el artículo 26 del Convenio de Barcelona y los artículos 4 ("Planes de urgencia y otros medios para prevenir y combatir sucesos de contaminación"), 7 ("Difusión e intercambio de información"), 9 ("Procedimiento de notificación"), 10 ("Medidas operacionales") y 16 ("Recepción de buques en peligro en puertos y lugares de refugio") del Protocolo de Cooperación para Luchar contra la Contaminación por Hidrocarburos y Otras Substancias Dañinas en Casos de Emergencia en el Mar Mediterráneo.

a) Cuadro I ("Medidas jurídicas y regulatorias"). El cuadro 1 simplifica el cuadro I ("Medidas jurídicas y administrativas") del formato actual, por ejemplo, diferenciando entre la presentación obligatoria y opcional de informes. La presentación de informes se vuelve opcional en el caso de los elementos voluntarios del Protocolo, con lo que las Partes Contratantes deben realizar un esfuerzo menor;

b) Cuadro II ("Medidas operacionales"). El cuadro II combina los cuadros V ("Medidas técnicas adoptadas") y VI ("Medidas operacionales adoptadas") del formato actual, en un intento por racionalizar y simplificar la presentación de información ofreciendo a las Partes Contratantes la flexibilidad que necesitan para subir datos tanto de las secciones pertinentes de los perfiles nacionales del Centro Regional de Respuesta a Situaciones de Emergencia de Contaminación Marina en el Mar Mediterráneo (REMPEC) o de los conjuntos de datos nacionales;

c) Cuadro III ("Sucesos de contaminación"). El cuadro III sustituye al cuadro VII ("Sucesos de vertido") del formato vigente. El nuevo cuadro copia la estructura de la base de datos del Sistema

Integrado de Información Geográfica del Mediterráneo para la Evaluación de los Riesgos de la Contaminación Marina y la Respuesta (MEDGIS-MAR) de modo que, si los datos ya se han presentado a través del MEDGIS-MAR, no es necesario volver hacerlo, con lo que se evita que se duplique la información procedente de diversas fuentes;

d) Los cuadros I a III ("Estado de la ratificación de los instrumentos jurídicos internacionales relacionados con el Protocolo de Cooperación para Luchar contra la Contaminación por Hidrocarburos y Otras Substancias Dañinas en Casos de Emergencia en el Mar Mediterráneo") del actual formato se han eliminado en el proyecto del formato revisado de presentación de informes, ya que esta información figura en el sitio web de la Organización Marítima Internacional (OMI).

13. <u>Sección 4 - Protocolo para la Protección del Mar Mediterráneo contra la Contaminación de</u> <u>Origen Terrestre:</u> Esta sección está organizada con el objetivo de facilitar el cumplimiento de las obligaciones de presentación de informes dimanantes del artículo 26 del Convenio de Barcelona y del artículo 13 del Protocolo para la Protección del Mar Mediterráneo contra la Contaminación de Origen Terrestre. El artículo 13 del Protocolo contiene la siguiente información: 1) datos estadísticos sobre las autorizaciones concedidas con arreglo al artículo 6 del Protocolo; 2) datos de las vigilancias, siguiendo lo estipulado en el artículo 8 del Protocolo; 3) la cantidad de contaminantes descargados desde sus territorios; y 4) los planes de acción, programas y medidas ejecutados conforme a los artículos 5, 7 y 15 del Protocolo.

a) Cuadro I ("Medidas jurídicas y regulatorias"). El cuadro I combina y simplifica los cuadros I ("Medidas jurídicas") y II ("Asignación de recursos") del presente formato, con lo que facilita la presentación de información acerca del marco jurídico o regulatorio establecido por las Partes Contratantes para aplicar el Protocolo para la Protección del Mar Mediterráneo contra la Contaminación de Origen Terrestre.

b) Cuadro II ("Inventario: artículo 13 c) del Protocolo para la Protección del Mar Mediterráneo contra la Contaminación de Origen Terrestre). El cuadro II sustituye al cuadro III-1 ("Datos estadísticos sobre las autorizaciones") y III-2 ("Cantidad de contaminantes descargados") del formato en vigor. Gracias al diseño del nuevo cuadro, no es necesario presentar datos que ya se hayan facilitado por medio del sistema del presupuesto nacional de contaminantes del Programa para la Evaluación y el Control de la Contaminación Marina en el Mar Mediterráneo (MED POL), con lo que se evita que se dupliquen los conjuntos de datos de que dispone el MED POL;

c) Cuadro III ("Ejecución y eficacia de los planes de acción regionales"). El proyecto del formato revisado de presentación de informes contiene un nuevo cuadro dedicado a la ejecución de los planes de acción regionales adoptados por las Partes Contratantes desde que aprobaron el actual formato. Entre ellos figuran: 1) planes de acción regionales sobre los contaminantes orgánicos persistentes; 2) planes de acción regionales sobre la reducción de los niveles de DBO5; 3) el Plan Regional sobre la reducción de los insumos de Mercurio (decisión IG.20/8.1); 4) el Plan Regional sobre la Gestión de los Desechos Marinos en el Mediterráneo (decisión IG.21/7); y 5) el Plan de Acción Regional sobre Consumo y Producción Sostenibles en el Mediterráneo (decisión IG.22/5);

d) Cuadros IV (*"Ejecución y eficacia de los planes de acción nacionales") y V* (*"Vigilancia").* Los cuadros IV y V son una versión perfeccionada de los cuadros V ("Ejecución de los planes de acción nacionales") y VI ("Ejecución de la vigilancia") del formato actual, y su objetivo es incluir las medidas más recientes e importantes de los planes de acción nacionales y sus indicadores para reflejar la naturaleza cambiante del marco del PNUMA/PAM.

14. <u>Sección 5 - Protocolo sobre las Zonas Especialmente Protegidas y la Diversidad Biológica</u> <u>del Mediterráneo:</u> El propósito de esta sección es facilitar el cumplimiento de las obligaciones de presentación de informes dimanantes del artículo 26 del Convenio de Barcelona y del artículo 23 del Protocolo sobre las Zonas Especialmente Protegidas y la Diversidad Biológica del Mediterráneo. De conformidad con el artículo 23, las Partes Contratantes tienen la obligación de informar sobre la ejecución del Protocolo y, en particular, sobre: 1) la situación y el estado de las zonas incluidas en la lista de zonas especialmente protegidas de interés para el Mediterráneo (ZEPIM); 2) todos los cambios que se hayan producido en la delimitación o la condición jurídica de las ZEPIM y las especies protegidas; y 3) las posibles exenciones contempladas en los artículos 12 y 18.

a) Parte V ("Vigilancia"). En el proyecto del formato revisado de presentación de informes se ha incorporado una nueva parte en la que se pretende reflejar la labor llevada a cabo en el Mediterráneo en relación con el Programa de Evaluación y Vigilancia Integradas (IMAP) y los indicadores de la biodiversidad pertinentes;

b) Parte VII ("Ejecución de los planes de acción regionales"). Se ha actualizado la parte del formato actual relativa a la ejecución de los planes de acción con vistas a incorporar los planes de acción regionales revisados y nuevos que se han aprobado desde que la 15.ª reunión de las Partes Contratantes del Convenio para la Protección del Medio Marino y de la Región Costera del Mediterráneo y sus Protocolos (COP 15) adoptó el formato vigente. Entre ellos figuran: 1) el Plan de Acción para la Conservación de los Peces Cartilaginosos (Condrictios) en el Mediterráneo (decisión IG.21/4), 2) el Plan de Acción Actualizado relativo a la Introducción de Especies y las Especies Invasoras en el Mar Mediterráneo (decisión IG.22/12), 3) el Plan de Acción Actualizado para la Conservación de los Cetáceos en el Mar Mediterráneo (decisión IG.22/12), 4) el Plan de Acción para la Conservación de la Vegetación Marina en el Mar Mediterráneo (decisión IG.20/6), 5) el Plan de Acción para la Conservación de las Especies de Aves Listadas en el Anexo II del Protocolo ZEP/BD (decisión IG.21/4), 6) el Plan de Acción para la Conservación de las Tortugas Marinas del Mediterráneo (decisión IG.21/4), 7) el Plan de Acción para la Conservación de las Formaciones Coralinas y otras Concreciones Biológicas Calcáreas en el Mar Mediterráneo (decisión IG.22/12), y 8) el Plan de Acción para la Conservación de Hábitats y Especies Asociados con los Montes Submarinos, Cuevas y Cañones Submarinos, Estructuras Afóticas

de Invertebrados Bentónicos y Fenómenos Quimiosintéticos en el Mar Mediterráneo (Plan de Acción de los Hábitats Oscuros) (decisión IG.21/4).

15. <u>Sección 6 - Protocolo "Offshore":</u> Esta sección está estructurada con miras a facilitar el cumplimiento de las obligaciones de presentación de informes contenidas en el artículo 26 del Convenio de Barcelona y el artículo 30 del Protocolo "Offshore". En virtud del artículo 30, las Partes Contratantes tienen la obligación de presentar información acerca de: 1) las autorizaciones concedidas con arreglo a la sección II, "Sistema de autorización"; 2) las autorizaciones concedidas con arreglo a la sección III, "Desechos y sustancias y materiales perjudiciales y nocivos"; y 3) los planes de intervención de urgencia (artículo 16).

a) Cuadro I ("Medidas jurídicas y regulatorias"). El cuadro I consolida los cuadros I ("Medidas jurídicas") y II ("Asignación de recursos") del presente formato y racionaliza aún más la presentación de información de acuerdo con la estructura del Protocolo "Offshore";

b) Cuadro II ("Permisos y cantidades"). El cuadro II sustituye a los cuadros III

("Autorización/permisos y datos técnicos conexos") y IV ("Excepciones del artículo 14") del formato actual. El nuevo cuadro ha sido concebido para recoger la información contemplada en los artículos 9 y 14 del Protocolo "Offshore" relativos a los permisos y las cantidades vertidas desde instalaciones *offshore*, los cuales hablan sobre la eliminación de sustancias y materiales perjudiciales o nocivos y sobre las excepciones aplicables en casos de fuerza mayor o para minimizar la contaminación;

c) Cuadro III ("Inventario de instalaciones offshore"). El cuadro III sustituye al cuadro V ("Retirada") del formato vigente. El inventario contenido en el proyecto del formato revisado de presentación de informes se ajusta, *mutatis mutandis*, al inventario de instalaciones retiradas y abandonadas en el nordeste del Atlántico del OSPAR.

16. El factor determinante ha sido el deseo de racionalizar las gestiones a nivel del PNUMA/PAM con los últimos progresos realizados en el marco del Convenio de Basilea, con lo que se ha facilitado la presentación de informes en virtud del Protocolo sobre la Prevención de la Contaminación del Mar Mediterráneo Causada por Movimientos Transfronterizos de Desechos Peligrosos y su Eliminación.

17. La 19.ª reunión de las Partes Contratantes (Atenas, Grecia, 9 a 12 de febrero de 2012) aprobó en su decisión IG.22/16 el formato de presentación de informes para la ejecución del Protocolo relativo a la Gestión Integrada de las Zonas Costeras (GIZC). Cuando se apruebe el formato revisado de presentación de informes, la secretaría pondrá en marcha las medidas necesarias para integrar el formato de presentación de informes del Protocolo relativo a la GIZC en el formato general del Convenio de Barcelona y sus Protocolos.

18. La puesta en práctica de esta decisión está asociada a los productos 1.2.1 y 1.5.2 del programa de trabajo propuesto. Tiene implicaciones presupuestarias para los recursos del Fondo Fiduciario del Mediterráneo (FFM), que quedan patentes en el presupuesto propuesto.
