







- El Acuerdo de París promete solo un tercio de lo que se necesita para evitar los peores impactos del cambio climático.
- La adopción de nuevas tecnologías en sectores clave podría reducir las emisiones en hasta 36 gigatoneladas anuales para 2030 -con una inversión menor a USD 100 por cada tonelada de carbono-, más que suficiente para saltar la brecha estimada actualmente.
- La Enmienda de Kigali al Protocolo de Montreal, la acción sobre los contaminantes climáticos de vida corta y aumentar la ambición de las promesas del G20 para el año 2020, también pueden ayudar a minimizar los impactos climáticos.


