## Draft criteria for selecting the theme of the Fourth Session of the UN Environment Assembly to be held in Nairobi on 15-19 March, 2019

The theme should, as far as possible, meet the following criteria:

- 1. Provide a targeted yet sufficiently interdisciplinary environmental policy focus that engages the economic and social spheres and has a significant scope for progress at global, regional and local levels.
- 2. Address issues of acute importance that builds on momentum of ongoing global initiatives and processes to help amplify the results.
- 3. Result in an actionable and solution-oriented outcome that is meaningful and inspiring to the world, to foster effective political will, mobilize cooperation and provide momentum to drive change on the ground.
- 4. Inspire citizens and generate partnerships between governments, the private sector, media and civil society to facilitate effective implementation of the outcome.
- 5. Ensure consistency between the themes of earlier Sessions of the Environment Assembly, to promote synergy and avoid duplication of work.
- 6. Support the implementation of the UN 2030 Agenda and its Sustainable Development Goals, and resonate with the annual themes of the High Level Political Forum.
- 7. Ensure alignment with UN Environment's core mandate and capacity, while at the same time being relevant to the broader UN family.
- 8. Promote the visibility and profile of the UN Environment Assembly.
- 9. Be easily understandable and communicable to all.
