Used Vehicles Key Issue

- Used vehicles a key issue for most African countries
- In East Africa 70% of GHG emissions coming from transport sector
- Providing opportunities and challenges
- Quality of cars being exported (diesel)
- Link to road safety
- System approach fuels issues/ maintenance/ urea/

Top 10 vehicles importing countries in Africa import ~800,000 vehicles

Examples

- More than 42 million used cars in Africa (2014)
- Mainly Japan (RHD) and Europe (LHD) + bit US
- Imports of used vehicles higher than new -Kenya 96% and Nigeria 99%
- internet based sales (-Nigeria 90%)



Country Examples

- Uganda The average age of diesel cars 16.4 years; and petrol cars 15.4 years (2014)
- Kenya 96% of cars imported are used; 8 year max results in relatively young fleet
- Liberia 90% used vehicles, 10% annual growth rate



Country Examples

Mauritius

- CO2 tax/ feebate scheme from 2011
- In 9 years cars efficiency approved by about 20%
- 50% discount excise duty on (H)EV
- (H)EV gone up from 43 to 1832 (2009 to 2014)
- 3 years max used vehicles age limit





- Clean tech policies (leapfrog)
- Information and awareness (labeling?)
- Harmonization (essential)

- "Used cars are inferior to new cars"
- "Used cars are polluting and thus should be banned"
- "Restricting access will deny access to affordable cars"
- "Quality cars are more expensive"
- "Restricting used cars will reduce revenue"
- "We can not maintain these cars"
- "It is impossible to regulate this trade"
