 - ❖ Better accountability & improved risk management

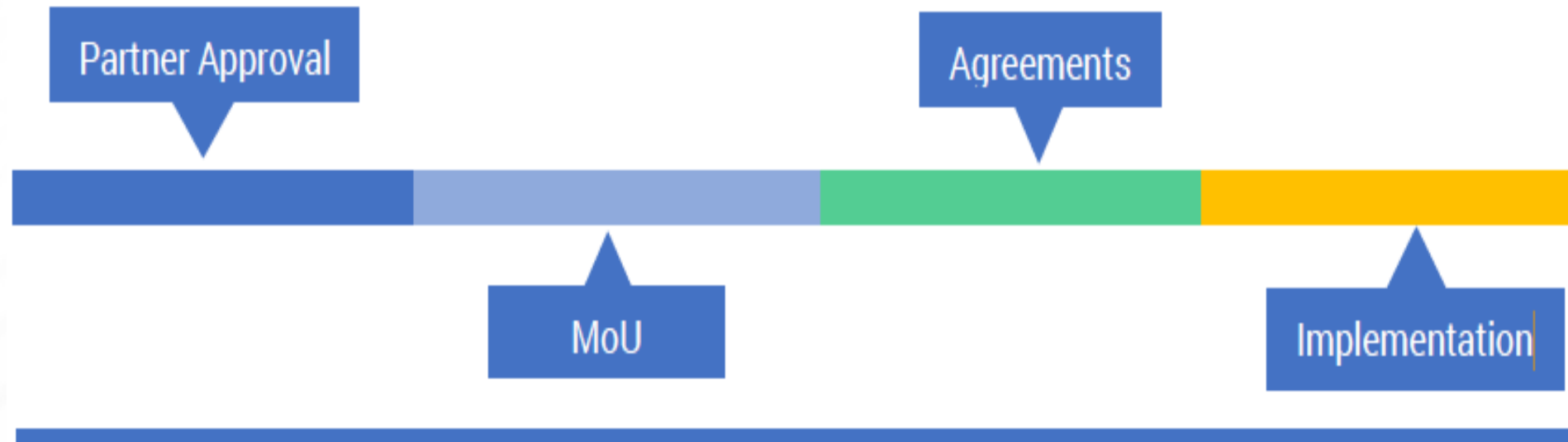
PRIVATE SECTOR UNIT

- ❖ Contributing to the UN Environment Assembly and implementing its outcomes
- ❖ Providing accountability to the Committee of Permanent Representatives.
