32 Years and Healing

32nd World Ozone Day is introduced by the UN Environment and celebrated in whole world. The Belgrade contributed by joining pupils, teachers and Principal of the Vocational Technical School „Novi Beograd“, students and professors from Department of Thermotechnics, University of Belgrade, servicing technicians, equipment importers, licenced engineers, representatives from Ministry of Ecology of the Republic of Serbia, members of the Serbian HVAC&R Society – all parties involved in, or responsible for ozone layer protection.

After welcome addresses by Prof. Branislav Todorović, the Serbian HVAC&R Society President, and Prof. Bratislav Blagojević, the SMEITS President, Ms Bojana Radeski Head of Group for Ozone Layer Protection, delivered her presentation on 32nd World Ozone Day, covering the ozone layer problem, solutions to the problem, and what the world jointly achieved in healing the ozone layer.

Slobodan Pejković, President to the Committee for Refrigeration, Heat Pumps and Energy Efficiency, within the Serbian HVAC&R Society, presented the current state of propane usage in Serbia.

A lively and open discussion started after the presentations, and continued during the cocktail.
