



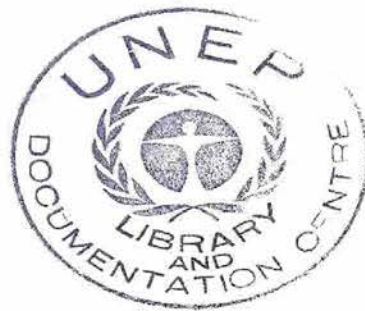

Introduction

This bibliography is the first publication in a series devoted to the documents produced by the United Nations Environment Programme. The purpose of the series is twofold: first, it serves as an inventory record of the holdings of the UNEP Library as well as a user's guide and second, it is hoped that it will stimulate interest in the work of UNEP on the part of interested organizations and individuals.

The United Nations Conference on the Human Environment held in Stockholm from 5 to 16 June was chosen as the topic of the first bibliography because UNEP, which was established by a subsequent resolution of the General Assembly, was first discussed and recommended by the Conference. This bibliography covers the documents submitted by States, the United Nations system, intergovernmental organizations, non-governmental organizations as well as other bodies and individuals. It also includes the documents prepared for and during meetings of preparatory committees, special working groups and the documents of the conference itself. Owing to the unavailability of complete sets of speeches and statements and the documents of the regional seminars, they have not been included; but it is hoped that once this material is available an addendum containing them will be issued.

With the exception of the basic documents, which are grouped together at the beginning of the bibliography, documents are grouped according to the meeting for which they were prepared. Main documents are listed first and secondary ones follow. Each document is identified by a document symbol composed of letters and numbers separated by oblique strokes. In cases where documents were not given official symbol numbers, symbols have been devised and added to facilitate organization and retrieval.

The document symbols provided not only identify each document but also give information on its origin and nature. All symbols begin with a letter or series of letters identifying the body or organization under whose authority the document was issued, e.g. A/CONF.48 = a United Nations conference convened by resolution of the General Assembly. The secondary elements of the symbol give further information. The ones used most frequently are the following:

1. Elements denoting a subsidiary organ As it is often essential to establish subsidiary organs such as committees, working groups, etc. to carry out effectively the work during a meeting, the documents prepared by these organs are identified by the use of letters or numbers. Thus the "C.1" following the basic document symbol A/CONF.48/C.1 indicates the first committee of the United Nations Conference on the Human Environment.

2. Elements denoting modifications of a text of a document Modifications are often made to the text of a particular document during the course of a meeting. These modifications are accomplished by means of the following:

Addendum	An addition to the text of a document, e.g. A/CONF.48/11/ <u>Add.1</u>
Amendment	An alteration of a portion of an adopted text, e.g. A/CONF.48/2/ <u>Amend.1</u>

Corrigendum	A modification of any specific part of an existing document to correct errors, revise wording or reorganize the text, whether for substantive or technical reasons, e.g. A/CONF.48/6/Corr.1
Revision	A new text which supersedes or replaces the entire text of a previously issued document for substantive or technical reasons, e.g. A/CONF.48/14/Rev.1
Supplement	Used to provide updated information. Usually, a supplement provides a major addition of information to an existing document, e.g. A/CONF.48/5/Supplement 1

3. Elements denoting distribution category Basic documents, reports, etc., are given a distribution status of "General" which means that these documents are given as wide a distribution as is appropriate to the meeting concerned. Some documents, however, which are of a more temporary nature are given only a limited distribution to those attending the meeting. Such documents are identified by the letter "L", e.g. A/CONF.48/L.3.

4. Elements denoting the nature of a document In this bibliography two types of documents bear these elements. First are the information series documents pertinent in subject content to the topics being discussed but not part of the deliberative process, e.g. A/CONF.48/Inf.1. The second are the conference room papers which are informal documents issued for discussion purposes, e.g. A/CONF.48/C.1/CRP.7.

The languages in which the documents were originally written or into which they have been translated are noted following the title of the document. Thus, a = Arabic, c = Chinese, e = English, f = French, r = Russian and s = Spanish.

The index which follows the bibliography covers, in alphabetical order, States, organizations, individuals and major subjects. After each entry are listed the documents pertaining to it. In cases where a whole series of documents pertains to a particular subject, these are indicated by an oblique stroke and a hyphen, e.g. A/CONF.48/PEIOI/-.
