



QUESTIONNAIRE

Based upon the input received, the following guiding questions are set out below.

I. <u>Guiding questions concerning the preparatory process</u>

1. The outcome reads: "Forward these recommendations to UNEA for its consideration".

a. Under which agenda item should UNEA 5 consider these recommendations?

EEG's Input:

We are of the opinion that these critical set of recommendations must be under a separate agenda item as they will require the adequate time for the accompanying discussion. It must also be noted that this will be a unique agenda item that has been especially recommended by the United Nations General Assembly and must therefore, be given the appropriate weightage and time. Having said this, it must be kept in mind that the existing agenda for UNEA-5 is already heavy and this should not overburden the Secretariat as well as those attending.

b. One option being under the inclusion in the already established item 5 of the provisional agenda entitled "International environmental policy and governance issues" or by recommending the establishment of a new item?

EEG's Input:

As mentioned previously, we do not think these recommendations must be added to an existing agenda item.

- 2. The outcome mandates: "to prepare, at its fifth session (...) a political declaration (...):
 - a. What level of detail should a text have in order to be considered by UNEA 5?

EEG's Input:

We believe that the Declaration must be appropriately worded, so every person reading is able to understand and decipher it easily. However, it must consist of certain essential elements such as an objective, the building blocks, a call for action and way forward.

> b. When should the "preparation of a political declaration" begin and what should be the recommended format, leadership and timeline of the preparatory process before UNEA 5?

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EEG's Input:

We are of the opinion that the Secretariat, along with the input of Member States and stakeholders, must prepare a comprehensive roadmap for the development of the Declaration. Once completed, it can be discussed at the Annual Subcommittee Meeting to discuss the way forward as well as delegate roles and responsibilities.

This is an important document that can only be considered 'ready' to be presented at UNEA-5 once it is read and approved by the entire gamut of Member States and stakeholders. It is this particular process that will require a fair amount of time and therefore, we recommend initiating it at the earliest.

c. How can accredited stakeholders be involved, and member States without representation in Nairobi participate, in the process?

EEG's Input:

As accredited Members, we will continue to participate in the process virtually through webinar. However, as mentioned to the Secretariat in the latter half of 2019, those not represented in Nairobi must be provided with enough time to connect and participate.

We found that a few Members asked to hold informal sessions in major cities including New York. We do not think this will work as too many consultations will dilute the process and provide an extra burden on the Secretariat to compile all the information.

- **3.** The outcome speaks about "a United Nations high-level meeting, subject to voluntary funding, in the context of the commemoration of the creation of the United Nations Environment Programme by the United Nations Conference on the Human Environment (...)".
 - a. What is meant by "a United Nations high-level meeting, subject to voluntary funding, in the context of the commemoration of the creation of the United Nations Environment Programme by the United Nations Conference on the Human Environment"?

EEG's Input:

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This question has been a point of contention for us. We believe that a commemoration event and the high-level meeting should be two separate events, independent of each other.

b. Who is expected to convene the UN high-level meeting? What should its format be?

EEG's Input:

We recommend that, as is the case with the Subcommittee meetings, this high-level meeting should be convened at Nairobi or New York. However, we request making appropriate arrangements for the general pool of Member States and stakeholders to attend via webinar.

The outcome also signals that the objective of the political declaration is "with a view to strengthening the implementation of international environmental law and international environmental governance, in line with paragraph 88 of the outcome document of the United Nations Conference on Sustainable Development, entitled
