- 10. States shall ensure to the maximum extent possible the survival and development of the child
- 11. In no case may a people be deprived of its own means of subsistence



- 1. The right of indigenous peoples to free, prior and informed consent
- 2. The right of indigenous peoples to the conservation and protection of their lands
- 3. The right of indigenous peoples to determine and develop priorities and strategies for the development or use of their lands or territories and other resources
- 4. The right to self-determination
- 5. The right of indigenous peoples to the lands, territories and resources that they have traditionally owned, occupied or used
- 6. The right of indigenous peoples to manifest, practise, develop and teach their spiritual and religious traditions, customs and ceremonies
- 7. The right of indigenous peoples to the improvement of their social and economic conditions
- 8. The right of indigenous peoples to maintain, protect, and have access to privacy to religious and cultural sites
- 9. All people may, for their own ends, freely dispose of their natural wealth
- 10. The right of indigenous peoples to be secure in the enjoyment of their own means of subsistence
- 11. The right of indigenous peoples to traditional knowledge and practices
- 12. The right of indigenous peoples to traditional medicines



- 1. The right to a clean environment
- 2. The right to the continuous improvement of living conditions
- 3. Prohibition from discrimination
- 4. All peoples have the right to freely determine their political status
- 5. The right of equal participation in political and public affairs
- 6. The right of access to information
- 7. The right to peaceful assembly and protest
- 8. The right to freedom of expression and association
- 9. The right to freedom from threats, harassment, intimidation, violence, arbitrary arrest and detention
