**African CSOs contribution to the Ministerial Declaration to UNEA-5.**

Your Excellencies, We the African CSOs accredited to UNEP, UNCCD and those committed in achieving the UN SDGs and Agenda 2030, African Union Agenda 2063, North-South and the South-South and Triangular Cooperation are concerned of the urgent need to address Environmental issues that relate to Land Tenure and Land Rights, loss of critical Ecosystems and their Niches, degraded lands and the encroachment of the Deserts, Loss of Species of Plants and Animals of great importance and interest and some which remain heavily threatened, disappearance of Forests and their Biodiversity, critical Watersheds and River Basins, the continuous increase in temperatures and Atmospheric Green House Gases, Advent of disasters and extreme Weather conditions like Droughts, Floods and sometimes diseases like COVID-19 and pests invasion, Pollution of the environment and Sea which have all been highlighted by many Environmental conventions, protocols and treaties and in many meetings and events around the world.

The effort put in place by various Governments, regional organizations and other stakeholder groups to arrest these challenges is much commended; however additional approach in a more holistic manner is needed to deal with the **real issues on the ground**. The participation of indigenous peoples and every stakeholder group in effectively achieving positive results and to bring an end to the sufferings of the majority of people in the Africa continent, those in rural communities who are directly attached to the natural resources and their enormous and valuable effort and contributions in protecting these resources but whose places are not known in the global scene rather neglected, are all more of our concern.

We are calling for UNEP and the International Community to make available additional **financial resources** directly mainly targeting organizations within the scope of UNEP to assist in carrying out actions on the ground in addressing land degradation and sustainable land management; pollution of the land, inland waters and sea; chemicals and waste; clean energy; climate change, and disasters, and the impacts of conflict, disasters and migration on the environment; sustainable food systems, Agro-ecology and regenerative agriculture; hunger and poverty; together in partnerships with the North-South, South-South and South-South Triangular Co-operation.

There exist a Co-ordinated Civil Society Platforms under UNEP-UNCCD CSOs. This Platform could adequately deliver the Goals and achieve the **World We Want** should additional funding resources be made available to the Platform.

We look forward to a fruitful cooperation and UNEA-5 outcome.
