2. UNEP Mid-Term Strategy narrative and budget approach.

UNEP Senior Management Team will present a draft narrative of the UNEP Mid-Term Strategy, based on the guidance received from the consultation sessions and from the Subcommittee meeting which took place on 4 June 2020. The Secretariat will also present an initial budget approach for the MTS. Member States are invited to provide guidance on the Mid-Term Strategy narrative and budget approach.

3. Implementation of paragraph 8 of UNEA Decision 4/2 on the commemoration of creation of UNEP.

The Secretariat will provide an update on the implementation of paragraph 8 of UNEA Decision 4/2, whereby the Executive Director is requested “to prepare, in consultation with Member States, the commemoration of the creation of UNEP by the UN Conference on the Human Environment held in Stockholm from 5 to 16 June 1972, making use of contributions from relevant stakeholders”, on the basis of a revised note taking into consideration the inputs received at the Subcommittee meeting held on 23 June 2020. Member States are invited to provide comments on the next steps on the implementation of this paragraph.

4. Update on the consultation process of the Future of Global Environment Outlook.

The Secretariat will present an update on the upcoming peer review and consultation process of the Future of Global Environment Outlook (GEO), including preparations for the online consultation sessions (webinars), and the current status of the Options Paper for the Future of GEO. Member States are invited to provide guidance on the peer review/consultation process, as well as inform the Secretariat of their preferred way of communicating with government experts.
