

## **Inputs from Ministry of Foreign Trade and Economic Relations of Bosnia and Herzegovina**

- Mainstreaming biodiversity into the strategic plans, development strategies and policies of different economic sectors (energy, transport, forestry, agriculture, fisheries and tourism) is crucial. It is necessary to ensure that sectoral and cross-sectoral policies, plans and programmes integrate actions for the conservation, sustainable use, management and restoration of biological diversity and ecosystems.
- Promoting and supporting the fair and equitable sharing of benefits arising from the use of genetic resources.
- Reducing negative and increasing positive incentives for the conservation and sustainable use of biodiversity.
- Make further efforts to implement measures and activities for the transition to a green economy.
- Bringing in mind that pollinators are fundamental for the conservation of biological diversity and the maintenance of natural terrestrial ecosystems and key ecosystem services, special attention should be focused on actions to protect pollinators and their habitats.
- Promoting transformative changes in the economic sector and implementing activities and interventions that will ensure the security of water, food and energy without endangering the well-being and health of ecosystems.
- Ensure the availability of scientific knowledge and data and strengthen scientific institutions.
