

2020 WORLD OZONE DAY IN MALAYSIA

In conjunction with the World Ozone Day celebrated every 16th of September, the Department of Environment (DOE) Malaysia through the Ministry of Environment and Water organized many activities to commemorate it. In line with this year's theme, "OZONE FOR LIFE, 35 years of ozone layer protection," ePosters, infographics and a short video competitions were held. Due to the current COVID-19 pandemic, dissemination of information was distributed extensively through social media via Facebook, Instagram and official DOE's website. A series of talks by NOU officers during Ozone Day celebrations at the State's level, besides online sessions via webinars, were held to boost awareness and promotion of ozone layer protection.

On 23rd September 2020, The Minister of Environment and Water, Datuk Seri Tuan Ibrahim Tuan Man graced the launching of the World Ozone Day 2020. Around 100 targeted participants comprising of stakeholders like Government officials, implementing agency, such as UNDP, and industry players attended the event held according to the new normal procedures in compliance with the COVID-19 guidelines. The highlight of the event was a plaque giving ceremony to foam premises that have completed their technology conversion from using ozone-depleting substances to alternatives as a symbol of the country's recognition for their participation, commitment and compliance towards the Montreal Protocol.
