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XIX Meeting of the Inter-Agency Advisory
Committee (IAAC) for MED POL

Athens, 13-17 January 1986

MINUTES

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1. The Meeting was convened by the Co-ordinating Unit for the Mediterranean Action Plan. All Co-operating Agencies (FAO, WHO, WMO, UNESCO, IOC, IAEA) and UNIDO were invited to attend the Meeting which took place at the office of the MED UNIT in Athens from 13 to 16 January 1986. The list of participants is attached as annex I.

2. Mr L. Jeftic opened the meeting and welcomed the participants. He noted that all invited Organisations were represented at the meeting with the only exception of UNIDO who had sent the following telex:

UNIDO further keen to collaborate with UNEP and other Agencies in following activities listed in same document: No 5 P.1 quote survey of land-based sources and amounts of pollutants reaching the Mediterranean Sea unquote semicln No 9 P.2 quote draft guidelines for the issue of authorization for the discharge of liquid wastes into the Mediterranean unquote semicln No 4 P.3 quote a comparative review of the various types of treatment in the Mediterranean areas for waste waters. unquote semicln No 5 P.3 quote compilation of detailed information and existing legislation measures regarding the discharge of wastes. unquote. BBB During recent travel to United States Maltezou contacted experts re assessing effect of pollution in Mediterranean Sea by used lubricating oils. Consultants are beginning work on this assignment. Regards (Eggough UNIDO Vienna)

Mr L. Jeftic underlined the importance of the present session of IAAC in view of the large number of actions and activities to be undertaken in the biennium 1986-1987 as a result of the decisions of the Genoa as well as the LBS expert meetings.

3. The Agenda was adopted as it appears in annex II.

4. Under Agenda item 1a (Review of activities since XVIII IAAC), Mr F.S. Cibili briefly reported on the status of the National Monitoring Agreements in the framework of MED POL-PHASE II (Annex III). The problem of the quality and coverage of the already available monitoring data was discussed. All the data received from the various countries were shown to the IAAC members for information prior to their distribution. The following distribution of responsibilities was made in order to confirm the general acceptability of the individual entries:

WHO: Microbiological data as well as data on sources
IOC: Standard physical and chemical parameters and petroleum hydrocarbons
IAEA: Contaminants in water and sediments
FAO: Contaminants in biota
WMO: Meteorological data

5. On the subject of the items of equipment distributed to the participating centres through the Agencies, it was agreed to transfer the property to the individual centres two years after the purchasing year.

12. Mr Mee also distributed an information paper reporting the list of services accomplished by the IAEA electronic engineer in MED POL participating countries (see Annex IX).

13. Under Agenda items 2, 3 and 4, the Group reviewed all the relevant decisions and recommendations of the Contracting parties Meeting in Genoa (September 1985), the Expert Meeting on the LBS Protocol (December 1985) and the III Meeting of the Working Group for Scientific and Technical Co-operation (May 1985). Each decision or recommendation was discussed and the relevant follow-up actions were planned. As a result, summary tables were prepared reporting the relevant decision, reference to the meeting report, the responsible officer or Agency, and, whenever necessary, details on the specific action and timetable. The tables are attached as annexes X, XI and XII. A separate table summarizing the meetings to be held in the biennium 1986-1987 is presented in Annex XIII.

14. Special emphasis was placed on the need for group training as a basic support for monitoring programmes. It was agreed that this activity should be encouraged and that related Agencies would report on their proposed activities in this field and budgetary requirements by the end of February.

15. Under Agenda item 5, decisions and recommendations contained in the minutes of the XVIII IAAC Meeting were reviewed. In particular, the group stressed the importance of the full implementation of the recommended procedures for the co-ordination of MED POL activities (UNEP/IAAC XVIII/2, annex III) and confirmed the validity of what had been recommended, with the exception of the procedure suggested in order to answer specific queries relevant to the quality of the monitoring data where it was felt that formal contacts with the Institutions should be maintained directly by the Unit. The Co-operating Agencies will provide technical advice on specific queries directly to the Unit. On the subject of the procedure relevant to the co-ordination of research projects the group decided that the outline of the progress and final reports and the reporting procedures agreed upon at the XVIII IAAC should be attached to each contract.

16. Under Agenda item 6, draft Agenda and list of documents to be presented to the IV Meeting of the Working Group for Scientific and Technical Co-operation were distributed. The two documents were revised and the final version appear in annex XIV. As to the preparation of the documentation, it was agreed that all inputs from the Agencies regarding research (all Agencies), maintenance (IAEA), intercalibration (IAEA, IOC, WHO) should be sent to the Unit by the end of February. The manuscripts of the Petroleum Hydrocarbons (IOC) and lubricating oils (UNIDO) assessments should be ready by the end of March, while the assessment on Metals (FAO) should be ready by the end of February and the assessment of shellfish (WHO) will be prepared when the relevant material is made available from the interested countries.

17. Under Agenda item 7, the Group felt that an exchange of information among the IAAC members on activities related to, but not part of, the Mediterranean Action Plan and co-ordinated by the Agencies, would be highly beneficial to the implementation of the MAP. The Agencies' representatives will explore the possibilities of such an exchange of information.
